Josh —Room 11 For following instructions and being respectful in maths rotations. Sienna –Room 12 For being an amazing friend.


Jane—Room 3 For achieving a goal and having lovely interactions with friends. Rose —Room 2 For being safe! Well done Rose.


This week room 12 has been getting excited about our beautiful weather; and having some fun in the sun with Blue Earth.


In Literacy we have been learning about the structure of letters and how to write one. We have even been writing letters to our friends and favourite movie characters.


