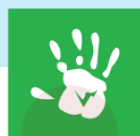

SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

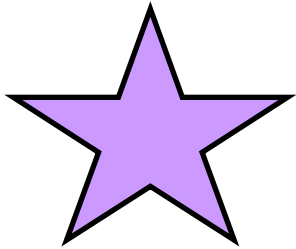
Nominations for school council election closed with the following results.

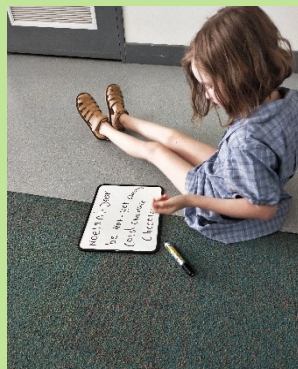
ROOM 9

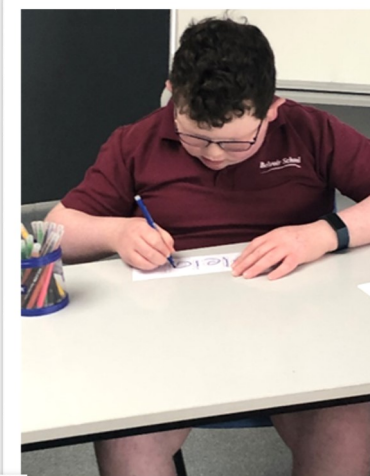
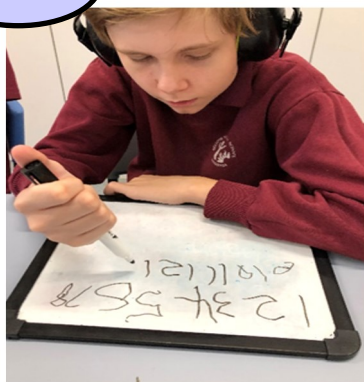
ROOM 18 NEWS

- These are some of my friends I hang out with.

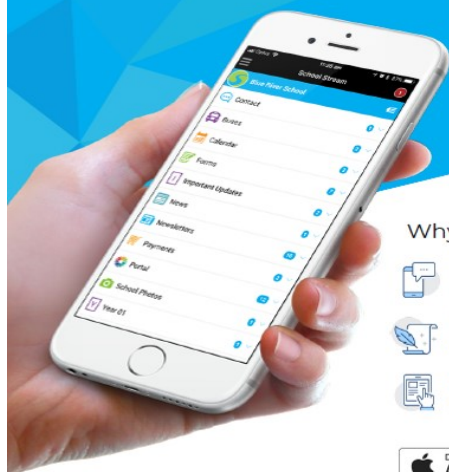
