COVID RESTRICTIONS

- Families coming inside the school gates for drop off and pick up must scan the QR code at the gates.

- Families will not be able to attend events until further notice.
- Students must not enter the school grounds prior to 8.45am. Main gate opens and onsite supervision starts at 8:45.




We have also been working on sharing/division in maths (we promised cleaned the tables after we drew on them!)



The Post School Expo will provide an opportunity for students and families to make an informed decision on post school options.


Students and families are encouraged to come along and chat to a range of services from our local community who can provide assistance in regards to post school options. NDIS providers will also be available to answer questions.


