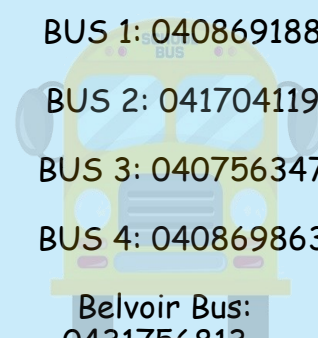

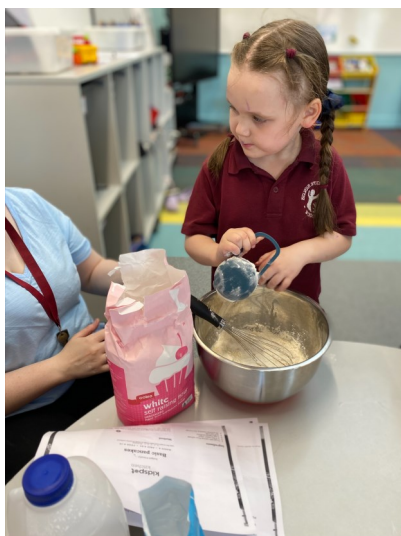
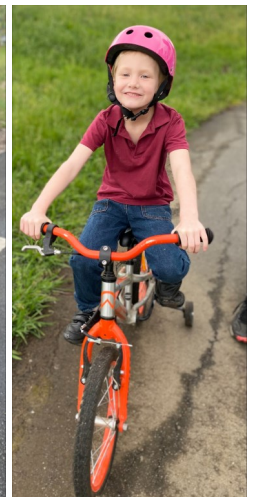


# ROOM 2 NEWS

We are looking forward to the last couple of weeks of term and all the fun activities planned.

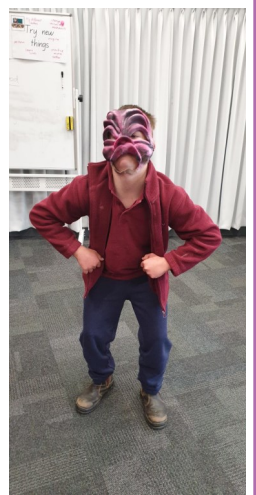
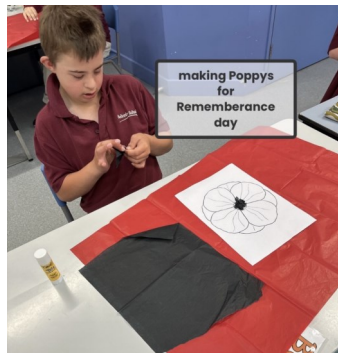




# ROOM 18 NEWS

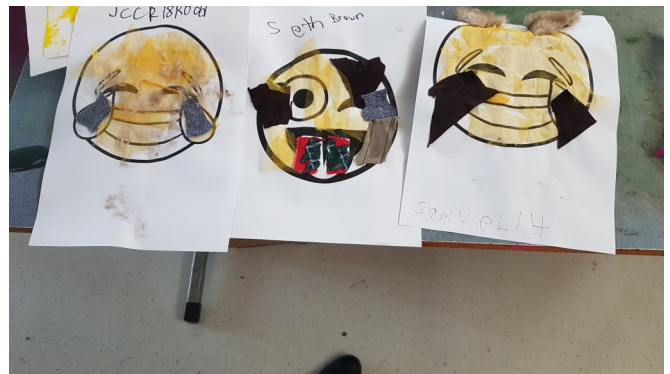
# Visual Art NEWS
