On Wednesday 23rd November, Belvoir Special School held our Post Schools Expo. It was fantastic to see so much support from the wider Belvoir School community after several years of absence. Over 20 different vendors were present and presented information about how they can assist parents in making sure that students at Belvoir get the best education possible. The expo also was an opportunity to show parents and vendors the new Vocational Pathways direction that Belvoir is taking to align with the new VPC. As of 2023 Belvoir has joined with Gre8 and National Food Institute and aligned with Merriwa Industries to create an SBAT (School Based Apprenticeship and Traineeship) program for Manufacturing. This means that our students will be completing the VPC three days a week and completing VET (Vocational Education and Training) and a work placement on the other two days. The plan is to then expand on our VET offerings in 2024 & 2025 to include Horticulture and Hospitality. Thanks to all those who helped set up and make it possible. A huge thank you to all those who attended. We can't wait to make this a regular part of the Belvoir Calendar moving forward and are already preparing for 2023.


ROOM 13 NEWS


