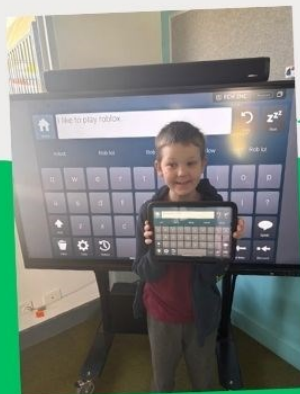
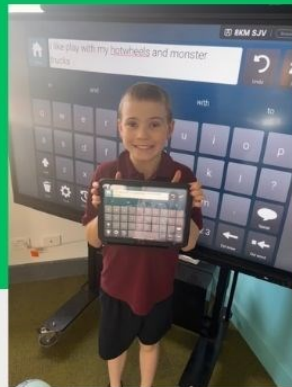


# ROOM 10 NEWS

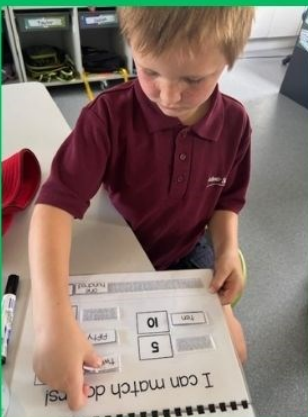

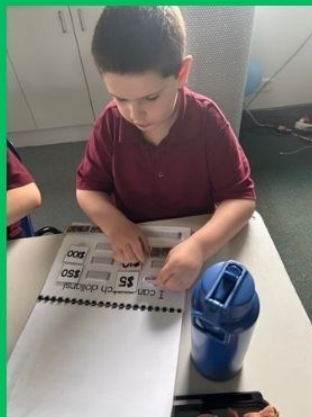

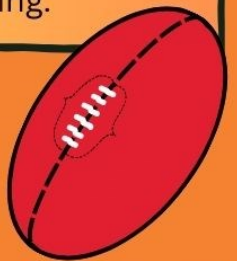
Whilst at The Men's Shed, students are currently building new serving trays to be used during staff café.
