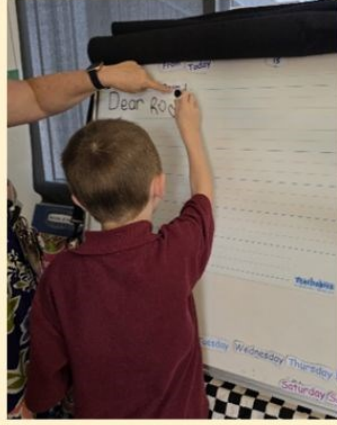

Over the holidays our Yellow Pod Playground got some new sand, we have had lots of fun playing in the big piles of sand during outside play.



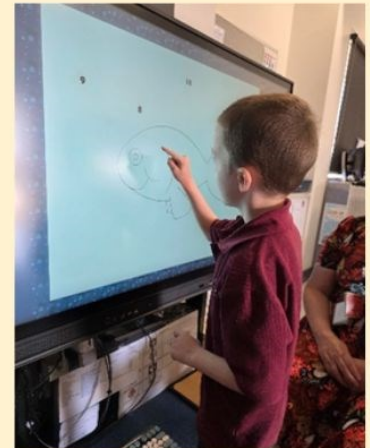
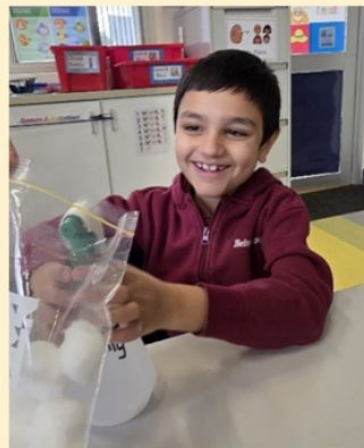
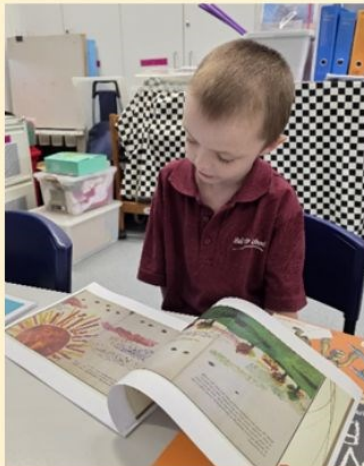

We planted our own tiny seeds into our own little greenhouses and will be watching eagerly to see if they grow. Parents- keep an eye on Seesaw for their progress!

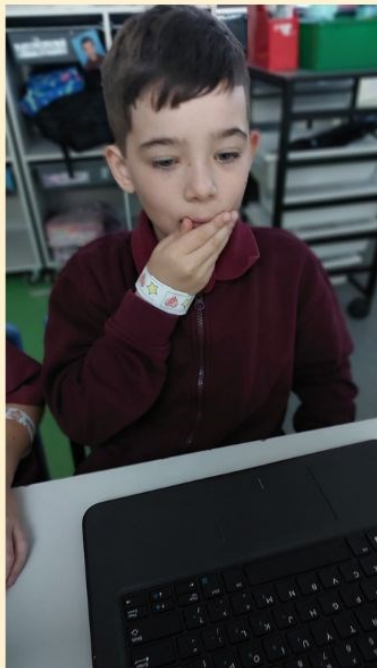
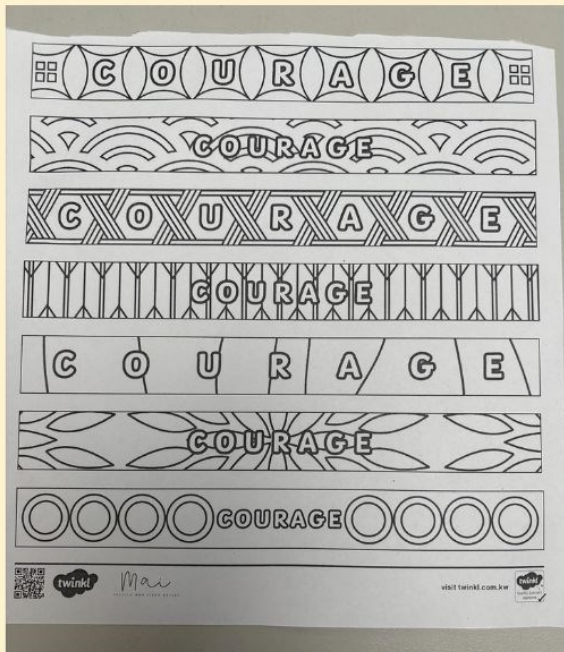

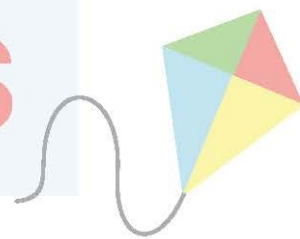
