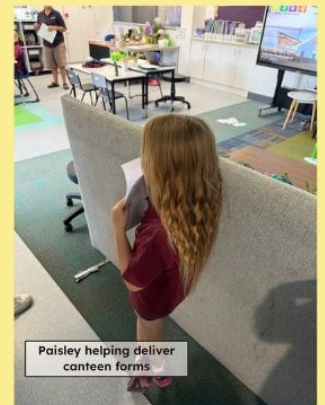

We have started our new inquiry this term and the students have enjoyed learning about the weather and how it can be measured.



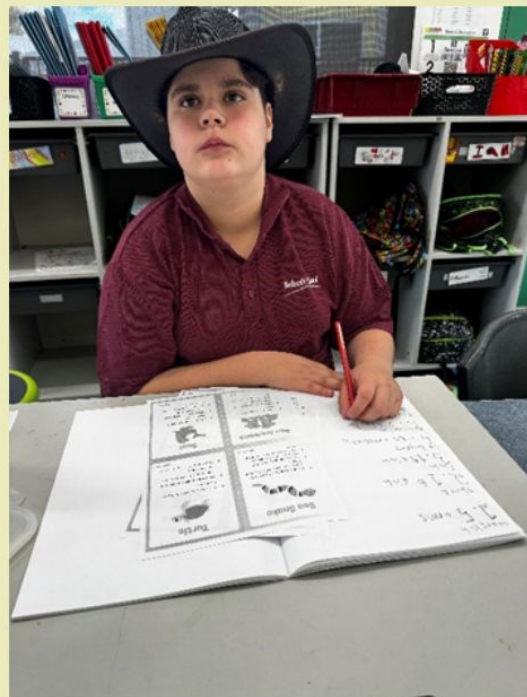
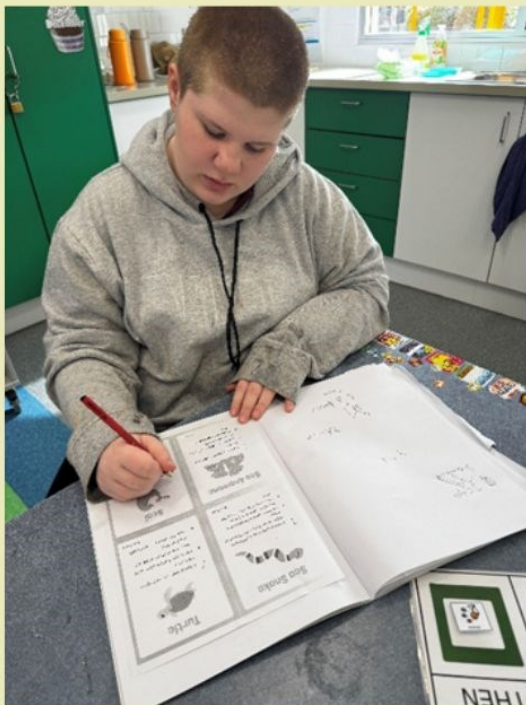

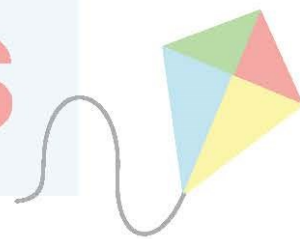
